

MEMBERSHIP ADMISSION NOTIFICATION

CAFAl's Executive Board adopted the Ordinance on admission to the membership of the CAFAl on October 10, 2020, and receives applications for membership until December 1 of the current year on the basis of Articles 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, and 17 of the CAFAl's Articles of Association dated February 8, 2019.

Ordinance on the admission of new members

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Article 1

Applications for membership are accepted throughout the year. The **Membership Committee** shall meet at least twice a year and no later than December 1st of the current year.

Article 2

Regular membership: Anyone who meets the following requirements may become a regular member of CAFAl: Croatian citizen or foreign national residing in the county of Istria, in the Republic of Croatia, with a diploma of an art academy, Croatian or foreign (in which case it must be translated and certified by a court), with which proves its education and academic or university degree (academic painter, Master painter, Ph.D. painter, academic sculptor, Master sculptor, Ph.D. sculptor, academic painter-graphic designer, etc.), as well as persons who do not have adequate education, but who meet the criteria of the Membership Committee, and who can prove it with the necessary documentation, and whose artistic creativity and public activities contribute to Croatian culture and art, as well as to the work and reputation of the Association.

Honorary membership: Anyone who does not meet the requirements from Article 1 of this Ordinance, Croatian citizen or foreign, who materially supports the activities of CAFAl, a public figure who contributes to the creativity as well as the artistic and multimedia culture, persons who, through their active work help the achievement of the objectives and activities of the Association and enrich and promote the affirmation of the work of the Association and its members can become honorary members.

The amount of material support is determined by the Management Board.

Proposals for honorary membership status must be submitted in writing to the Executive Committee which, after examining the explanation, will decide whether to take the proposal to the Assembly for a vote.

Article 3

The decision on admission to regular membership shall be taken by the Executive Board on a proposal from the Membership Committee, and on the basis of the documentation of registered candidates, determined by the Ordinance on the admission of new members. The Executive

Board may request the Membership Committee to explain the proposal for each of the candidates.

The Executive Board shall report on the admission of new members at the upcoming Annual Assembly.

Article 4

In order to become a regular member of the CAFAI, one must pay the annual membership fee and be registered in the Membership register.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Article 5

For the submission of applications for admission to regular membership, the persons referred to in Article 2 of the Ordinance must provide basic information and documentation which fulfills the terms for the application.

BASIC INFORMATION

Article 6

Required application documents:

- application letter
- biography
- copy of the diploma, i.e. a nostrification of professional education
- foto documentation of works or artistic projects.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

Article 7

Academic painters, sculptors, graphic artists, and other artists with a degree (Croatian or nostrified) of one of the distinguished visual arts colleges or higher education institutions must provide the following documentation:

CV/catalogs, photographs of an artistic portfolio

Academics of art culture and art teachers must provide the following documentation:

CV/catalogs, photographs of an artistic portfolio.

Persons of other professions must provide the following documentation: CV/catalogs, photographs on participation in at least three curated selective exhibitions.

Any person that contributes with their activity to the work and development of the Association can become an honorary member.

CONSIDERATION OF THE TERMS

Article 8

The terms of Articles 6 and 7 shall be taken into consideration by The Membership Committee composed of five members appointed by the Executive Board for four years.

Article 9

On the basis of the documentation of the applicants, The Membership Committee will make a decision on membership.

Additionally, The Committee may request from the candidates to deliver their works for insight - five paintings or graphic sheets, two sculptures, or two videos.

Article 10

The decision on the admission of candidates to the membership is taken by The Membership Committee based on the majority of the votes and is confirmed by the Management Board.

OTHER PROVISIONS

Article 11

The candidate who has not been admitted to the membership has the right to appeal to the Management Board within eight days of the publication of the decision.

The decision of the Management Board is final and the candidate has no right to appeal.

Article 12

Applications for admission are submitted to the Secretary. The Secretary organizes the entire procedure concerning the application of candidates for membership in the Association in accordance with the articles of this Ordinance.

Article 13

With the day of adoption of this Ordinance all previous decisions, conclusions, and regulations on membership admission cease to apply.
